- The Project:
- Students must bring only what is on their back (in a backpack) to the shelter.
 - Students may want to pack toiletries and a washcloth, but keep in mind we will not have access to showers and all belongings must fit in a backpack.
 - Students must bring only \$20 each (probably more than they would have if they were truly homeless) for meals.
 - No iPods, cell phones, laptops or other electronic devices. Just you, your clothes and your community for the week.
