Things You Need to Know

Schedule

- Leave from Hope Monday, June 21, 6 am
- Return to Hope Sunday, June 27, 5 pm

Full itineraries will be handed out the day we leave and emailed to parents who do not get a hard copy.

Weather

Highs will reach the 90s during the days. We will be in the mountains and in the shade much of the time and the climate is far less humid than we are used to, so it will feel cooler. The temperature could get down into the high 40s in the evenings/nights, so pack some warmer clothes.

Bring List

We are responsible to bring our own camping equipment. Each team member should plan to bring the following:

- Sleeping bag/air mattress
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Bible
- Pen
- Sunscreen
- Hand sanitizer
- Baby wipes
- Moisturizer, chapstick (The air will be very dry.)
- Closed-toed shoes for hiking, etc.
- Personal snacks
- Toilet Paper

If you have a tent, lantern or other camping equipment you would allow us to use, please let us know.

Amenities (Or the lack thereof)

There will be no running water or electricity at camp. Students are encouraged to bring car chargers for cell phones, iPods. The camp will provide 3 meals a day plus drinking water. Students may bring personal snacks/drinks for the drive.

Electronic Equipment

Students will be allowed to bring iPods and cell phones and may use these on the trip in vehicles. Use will be very limited once we arrive at camp, however. There will be designated times when students may check in with parents via cell phone.

Clothing

In order to be culturally sensitive, please no tank tops. Also, shorts must be no shorter than 3" above the knee.
