TAKING HOPE TO THE WORLD

Did you know missionaries serve on mission trips, too?

Dan and Michelle Mueller are a missionary couple that Hope has supported for many years. They serve with Wycliffe Bible Translators in Papua, Indonesia. Dan heads up a school for missionary children in the area, and Michelle is a nurse.

Recently Dan led 61 high school students on a work camp to the south coast of Papua. The group was split up with half serving in the town of

Merauke, and the other half serving in a village 3 hours away.

The work project for the students was in a swamp area so the students had to deal with dehydration and leaches, among other things. They built fences, painted churches, held kids clubs and much more.

Michelle spent her time serving medical needs in the village. She said when they arrived, the local health worker was gone and there were no medicines available. One patient she

treated had had an infection in his ankle for four years. The team's presence at that time may have saved the man from losing his leg.

The Mueller's wrote: "Thanks for your prayers and support. The Lord is good and we wait to be used as He wills. Please pray for us to have strength as we reach the end of the year and for good relationships with our co-workers and Indonesian staff."

The LORD said to him: "I have heard the prayer and plea you have made before me; I have consecrated this temple, which you have built, by putting my Name there forever. My eyes and my heart will always be there.
